- Certain ones returning to Israel after the exile could not establish their origins as to whether they were Israelites.
- And these were the ones going up from Tel-melah, Tel-harsha, Cherub, Addon and Immer, and they proved unable to tell the house of their fathers and their origin, whether they were of Israel. (Ezra 2:59)
- And these were the ones going up from Tel-melah, Tel-harsha, Cherub, Addon and Immer, and they were not able to tell the house of their fathers and their origin, whether they were of Israel. (Nehemiah 7:61)
- Israel's origin first came forth from the land of Canaan. There they saw many depraved sexual practices and the disgusting practice of child sacrifice. Thus they were brought up in this climate of wicked and disgusting practices.
- And you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to Jerusalem; Your origin and your birth were from the land of the Canaanite. Your father was the Amorite, and your mother was a Hittite. (Ezekiel 16:3)
- The land of Christendom's origin is a land of apostasy. At the end of the First Century of our Common Era when God shut off all spiritual light from all the peoples of the earth, Christendom then got her start.
- She has loved prominence and titles and committed fornication with earth's many kings. Her judgment was set from the earliest of times.

- And you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, the one too little to get to be among the thousands of Judah, from you there will come out to me the one who is to become ruler in Israel, whose origin is from early times, from the days of time indefinite. (Micah 5:2)
