(Oth'ni) [shortened form of Othniel]

- Son of Shemaiah and grandson of Korahite Obed-edom, appointed as a Levite gatekeeper before the sanctuary. Othni and his brothers were rulers of the house of their father, capable, mighty men.
- For the divisions of gatekeepers. Of the Korahites, Meshelemiah the son of Kore of the sons of Asaph. (1 Chronicles 26:1)
- And Obed-edom had sons, Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third and Sacar the fourth and Nethanel the fifth. (1 Chronicles 26:4)
- And to Shemaiah his son there were sons born that were rulers of the house of their father, for they were capable, mighty men. (1 Chronicles 26:6)
- The sons of Shemaiah, Othni and Rephael and Obed, Elzabad, whose brothers were capable men, Elihu and Semachiah. (1 Chronicles 26:7)
- All these were of the sons of Obed-edom, they and their sons and their brothers, capable men with the power for the service, sixty-two belonging to Obed-edom. (1 Chronicles 26:8)
- Obed-edom had his to the south, and his sons had the storehouses. (1 Chronicles 26:15)
