## ~OVERFLOW (125)

[English, run over, flood, spread out, spill over, brim over, pour out]

- Yehowah God wanted ther Israelites to give freely of the overflow of their abundant blessing to his house of worship.
- Your full produce and the overflow of your press you must not give hesitantly. The firstborn of your sons you are to give to me. (Exodus 22:29)
- Yehowah God made the waters of the Red Sea to overflow upon the troops of Pharaoh causing them all to drown in the waters.
- Nor what he did to the military forces of Egypt, to his horses and his war chariots against the faces of which he made the waters of the Red Sea overflow when they were chasing after them, and Yehowah proceeded to destroy them till this day. (Deuteronomy 11:4)
- Yehowah God promised to make his people overflow with blessings, the fruit of the ground, domestic animals and their own offspring.
- Yehowah will also make you overflow indeed with prosperity in the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your ground, on the ground that Yehowah swore to your forefathers to give you. (Deuteronomy 28:11)
- The Psalmist showed that with tears his divan had overflowed at night.
- I have grown weary with my sighing, all night long I make my couch swim, with my tears I make my own divan overflow. (Psalms 6:6)
- In Yehowah God's New Order he promises to make the mountains, or governments of the earth, overflow with grain and new wine causing rejoicing everywhere.
- There will come to be plenty of grain on the earth, on the top of the mountains there will be an overflow. His fruit will be as in Lebanon, and those who are from the city will blossom like the

## vegetation of the earth. (Psalms 72:16)

- The blessing of Yehowah God includes their stores of supply overflowing with plenty.
- Then your stores of supply will be filled with plenty, and with new wine your own press vats will overflow. (Proverbs 3:10)
- His promise to them then, if they do thus, is that their threshing floors where the grain is beaten out, will be full of cleansed grain, and that their press vats, holding the fruitage of the vine and olive trees, wine and oil, will overflow from all the abundance that he brings to them then. This promise above will only be realized, by the repentant remnant of his spirit anointed sons in this time of the end, who return to him with all the heart, and that is why the above verses constitute a Messianic promise.
- And the threshing floors must be full of cleansed grain, and the press vats must overflow with new wine and oil. (Joel 2:24)
- The harvest of the earth has indeed come to fruition, the crop of badness among the nations of the earth today, has fully ripened. So he commands his angelic armies to descend, for the winepress has become full, and the press vats have become full, and are overflowing, for the badness of mankind has become abundant in all the earth, and he has come to put a stop to it, similar to what he did in the days of Noah.
- Thrust in a sickle, for harvest has grown ripe. Come, descend, for the winepress has become full. The press vats actually overflow, for their badness has become abundant. (Joel 3:13)
- So Zechariah is told to cry out to the people of Judah, that Yehowah has said, that his cities will yet overflow with goodness. Also, that Yehowah will certainly feel regrets over Zion, his ruling authority, and he will yet choose Jerusalem, as the place of his residence among all the earth.
- Call out further, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; My cities will yet overflow with goodness, and Yehowah will yet certainly feel regrets over Zion and yet actually choose Jerusalem. (Zechariah 1:17)

- Paul wanted their exultation to overflow in Christ Jesus, through his own visit to them.
- So that your exultation may overflow in Christ Jesus by reason of me through my presence again with you. (Philippians 1:26)
- Peter now states that if these above mentioned things exist within anointed Christian sons of God, and overflow outward toward others, that they will prevent them from either becoming inactive of unfruitful, regarding the accurate knowledge of Jesus Christ. They then will be putting into practice all that they learn, and being outgoing and giving toward others, and this will protect them in the future.
- For if these things exist in you and overflow, they will prevent you from being either inactive or unfruitful regarding the accurate knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:8)
