**[English, delighted, joyful, elated, estatic, jubilant, thrilled, Opposite of, disappointed]**

- Mary spoke of being **overjoyed** at God my savior.
- And my spirit cannot keep from being **overjoyed** at God my Savior. (**Luke 1:47**)
- Jesus became **overjoyed** in spirit and praised Yehowah for giving understanding to babes, while hiding it from intellectual ones.
- In that very hour he became **overjoyed** in the Holy Spirit and said; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have carefully hidden these things from wise and intellectual ones, and have revealed them to babes.
