~OVERSTEPPED (78)

[English, transgressed, violated, disregarded, disobeyed, contravened, broke, Opposite of, obeyed]

- In the third year Israelites were to give their firstfruits of their produce to the Levites to distribute to needy ones, so as not to overstep Yehowah God's commandments.
- And you must say before Yehowah your God, I have cleared away what is holy from the house and I have also given it to the Levite and the alien resident, the fatherless boy and the widow, in accord with all your commandment that you have commanded me. I have not overstepped your commandments, nor have I forgotten. (Deuteronomy 26:13)
- Achan overstepped Yehowah God's commandments bringing all Israel into a disapproved condition before Yehowah God.
- Israel has sinned, and they have also overstepped my covenant that I laid as a command upon them, and they have also taken some of the thing devoted to destruction and have also stolen and also kept it secret and have also put it among their own articles. (Joshua 7:11)
- And it must occur that the one picked with the thing devoted to destruction will be burned with fire, he and all that belongs to him, because he has overstepped the covenant of Yehowah and because he has committed a disgraceful folly in Israel. (Joshua 7:15)
- Yehowah God's anger blazed against Israel, because they had overstepped his commandments.
- Finally Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel and he said; For the reason that this nation have overstepped my covenant that I commanded their forefathers and have not listened to my voice. (Judges 2:20)
- Saul admitted to Samuel that he had overstepped the commandments of Yehowah God.
- Then Saul said to Samuel; I have sinned. For I have overstepped

the order of Yehowah and your words, because I feared the people and so obeyed their voice. (1 Samuel 15:24)

- Yet Yehowah God calls his people Israel to account, stating that they have overstepped the covenant, whether the Law Covenant, or today, the New Covenant. In their not keeping these covenants, they have acted treacherously with their God. Their knowledge of him is only superficial, and they do not follow his way of truth and righteousness closely, as they have agreed to do while in covenant with him their God, through dedication and baptism.
- But they themselves, like earthling man, have overstepped the covenant. There is where they have dealt treacherously with me. (Hosea 6:7)
- Yehowah now calls for them to raise a horn, as an alarm to the people, for he is coming like an eagle against the house of Yehowah. They have overstepped his covenant and transgressed against his Law. They are not living up to their agreements of dedication to him, through the Law Covenant and now through New Covenant.
- To your mouth, a horn! One comes like an eagle against the house of Yehowah, for the reason that they have overstepped my covenant, and against my Law they have transgressed. (Hosea 8:1)
