[English, transgress, violate, disregard, disobey, contravene, break,
Opposite of, **obey**]

- Moses warned what to do about a man or woman doing bad who **oversteps** the commandment of Yehowah.
- In case there should be found in your midst in one of your cities that Yehowah your God is giving you a man or a woman who should practice what is bad in the eyes of Yehowah your God so as to **overstep** his covenant. (**Deuteronomy 17:2**)
- Jesus apstotles were accused of **overstepping** the commandment of former times by not washing before a meal. Actually this was tradition and not a commandment of God and so it was really not important.
- Why is it your disciples **overstep** the tradition of the men of former times? For example, they do not wash their hands when about to eat a meal. (**Matthew 15:2**)
- Jesus countered their argument with one that was truly important for thy error by their traditions handed down by other men **overstepping** the true commandments of their God Yehowah.
- In reply he said to them; Why is it you also **overstep** the commandment of God because of your tradition? (**Matthew 15:3**)
