

~OVERTAKEN (34)

[English, passed, went beyond, went past, overhauled, left behind, outdid, surpassed, Opposite of, **fell behind**]

- Moses requested Edom to allow Israel to pass by their territory because of all the hardship that had **overtaken** them along the way.
- Subsequently Moses sent messengers from Kadesh to the king of Edom; This is what your brother Israel has said; You yourself well know all the hardship that has **overtaken** us. (**Numbers 20:14**)
- Judah, because of her own badness was sent into exile and those persecuting her have **overtaken** her under distressing circumstances.
- Judah has gone into exile because of the affliction and because of the abundance of servitude. She herself has had to dwell among the nations. No resting-place has she found. All those who were persecuting her have **overtaken** her among distressing circumstances. (**Lamentations 1:3**)
- Jesus warned the Scribes and the Pharisees that if his power was from God then the Kingdom of God had really **overtaken** them.
- But if it is by means of God's spirit that I expel the demons, the kingdom of God has really **overtaken** you. (**Matthew 12:28**)
- But if it is by means of God's finger I expel the demons, the kingdom of God has really **overtaken** you. (**Luke 11:20**)
