~OVERTHROW (142)

[English, conquer, defeat, remove from power, put an end to, cause the downfall of, bring down, oust, depose, topple]

- Yehowah God saved righteous Lot out from the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah.
- And it came about that when God brought the cities of the District to ruin God kept Abraham in mind in that he took steps to send Lot out of the midst of the overthrow when overthrowing the cities among which Lot had been dwelling. (Genesis 19:29)
- Yehowah God promised to turn his own people's land into a place like Sodom and Gomorrah and overthrow them there, if they proved disobedient.
- Sulphur and salt and burning, so that its whole land will not be sown, nor sprout, nor will any vegetation spring up in it, like the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah and Zeboiim, which Yehowah overthrew in his anger and in his wrath. (Deuteronomy 29:23)
- The princes of Ammon told Hanun, that David sent men to their city to overthrow it, after first spying it out.
- However, the princes of the sons of Ammon said to Hanun their lord; Is David honoring your father in your eyes in that he has sent to you comforters? Is it not for the sake of searching through the city and to spy it out and to overthrow it that David has sent his servants to you? (2 Samuel 10:3)
- However, the princes of the sons of Ammon said to Hanun; Is David honoring your father in your eyes in that he has sent comforters to you? Is it not for the sake of making a thorough search and causing an overthrow and for spying out the land that his servants have come in to you? (1 Chronicles 19:3)
- Darius ordered that Yehowah God should overthrow any king who would thrust out his hand to harm Yehowah God's temple.
- And may the God who has caused his name to reside there overthrow any king and people that thrusts his hand out to

commit a violation and destroy that house of God, which is in Jerusalem. I, Darius, do put through an order. Let it be done promptly. (Ezra 6:12)

- Job shows that the true God recognizes the works of apostates and wicked ones, and he does overthrow them at night.
- Therefore he recognizes what their works are, and he does overthrow them at night, and they get crushed. (Job 34:25)
- A flattering mouth causes an overthrow.
- A tongue that is false hates the one crushed by it, and a flattering mouth causes an overthrow. (Proverbs 26:28)
- Yehowah views their land as already a desolation with her cities burned with fire, because her spiritual condition is not recoverable. Her leaders allow strangers to come in and eat up the God given land inheritance, taking it permanently away from the sons of Israel. The desolation is extensive, like the overthrow from a foreign nation.
- Your land is a desolation, your cities are burned with fire, your ground, right in front of you strangers are eating it up, and the desolation is like an overthrow by strangers. (Isaiah 1:7)
- She will become a desolate waste uninhabited for times indefinite. Her overthrow will be like that of Sodom and Gomorrah. No man will ever dwell there again.
- Just as in the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah and her neighbor towns, Yehowah has said; No man will dwell there, and no son of mankind will reside in her as an alien. (Jeremiah 49:18)
- To this day no man dwells in Sodom or Gomorrah. Likewise no man will dwell within false religion to time indefinite. She will be completely overthrown without an inhabitant.
- Just as with God's overthrow of Sodom and of Gomorrah and of her neighbor towns, is the utterance of Yehowah, no man will dwell there, nor will the son of mankind reside in her as an alien. (Jeremiah 50:40)
- Yehowah even caused an overthrow among his people like the overthrow he earlier caused to Sodom and Gomorrah, and they came to

be before him like a log snatched out of a fire, thus escaping from sure destruction, but even then they did not return to him in repentance.

- I caused an overthrow among you people, like God's overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah. And you came to be like a log snatched out of the burning, but you did not come back to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Amos 4:11)
- Yehowah then promised to overthrow the throne of kingdoms, and to annihilate the strength of the kingdoms of the nations. Clearly this has a further application to the Messianic rule of Christ. Then Yehowah God will overthrow the chariot and its riders, men of war, and also the horses and their riders will certainly come down, for they will all turn upon one another in war, as Yehowah many times did to enemies coming against his people Israel.
- And I shall certainly overthrow the throne of kingdoms and annihilate the strength of the kingdoms of the nations, and I will overthrow the chariot and its riders, and the horses and their riders will certainly come down, each one by the sword of his brother. (Haggai 2:22)
- On the other hand, if this work was truly from God, neither they nor anyone else would be able to overthrow them. Also, if they kept on this course of persecuting them, then they might actually be found to be fighters against Yehowah God himself. Does not history show, that their work was from Yehowah God, for it did not come to nothing nor did it get overthrown.
- But if it is from God, you will not be able to overthrow them, otherwise, you may perhaps be found fighters actually against God. (Acts of Apostles 5:39)
