

## ~OVERTURNED (41)

[English, upturned, wrong way up, wrong side up, on its head, inverted, reversed, Opposite of, upright]

- Jeremiah felt that his heart had been **overturned** in the midst of him over the fall of Jerusalem and her peoples being led into exile.
- See, O Yehowah, for I am in sore straits. My very intestines are in a ferment. My heart has been **overturned** in the midst of me, for I have been absolutely rebellious. Outside the sword caused bereavement of children. Within the house it is the same as death. (**Lamentations 1:20**)
- Jesus entered into the temple and **overturned** the tables of the money-changers for they had no rightful place in the temple which was a house of prayer for all the peoples.
- And Jesus entered into the temple and threw out all those selling and buying in the temple, and **overturned** the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. (**Matthew 21:12**)
