[English, upturned, wrong way up, wrong side up, on its head, inverted, reversed, Opposite of, upright]

- Jeremiah felt that his heart had been overturned in the midst of him over the fall of Jerusalem and her peoples being led into exile.
- See, O Yehowah, for I am in sore straits. My very intestines are in a ferment. My heart has been overturned in the midst of me, for I have been absolutely rebellious. Outside the sword caused bereavement of children. Within the house it is the same as death. (Lamentations 1:20)
- Jesus entered into the temple and overturned the tables of the money-changers for they had no rightful place in the temple which was a house of prayer for all the peoples.
- And Jesus entered into the temple and threw out all those selling and buying in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves.

 (Matthew 21:12)
- Now they came to Jerusalem. There he entered into the temple and started to throw out those selling and buying in the temple, and he overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. (Mark 11:15)
- So, after making a whip of ropes, he drove all those with the sheep and cattle out of the temple, and he poured out the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables. (John 2:15)
- Paul was accused of be of the sect that had overturned the entire inhabited earth with their teachings.
- When they did not find them they dragged Jason and certain brothers to the city rulers, crying out; These men that have overturned the inhabited earth are present here also. (Acts of Apostles 17:6)
