(Pa'a-rai) [possibly from a root meaning, open wide]

- An Arbite and one of the mighty men of David's military forces.
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David. Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. (2 Samuel 23:8)
- Hezro the Carmelite, Paarai the Arbite. (2 Samuel 23:35)
- He may be identical with the Naarai mentioned at;
- Hezro the Carmelite, Naarai the son of Ezbai. (1 Chronicles 11:37)
