

~PAROSH (66)
(Pa'rosh) [Flea]

- **Founder of a family in Israel. There were 2,172 of his descendants who returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.**
- **And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)**
- **Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)**
- **The sons of Parosh, two thousand one hundred and seventy-two. (Ezra 2:3)**
- **The sons of Parosh, two thousand one hundred and seventy-two. (Nehemiah 7:8)**
- **By the time that Ezra arrived in 468 B.C.E, with 150 sons of Parosh led by Zechariah, some of their family already in Jerusalem had taken foreign wives, whom they later sent away.**
- **Now these were the heads of their paternal houses and the genealogical enrollment of those going up with me during the reign of Artaxerxes the king out of Babylon. (Ezra 8:1)**
- **Of the sons of Shecaniah, of the sons of Parosh, Zechariah, and with him there was an enrollment of a hundred and fifty males. (Ezra 8:3)**
- **And of Israel, of the sons of Parosh there were Ramiah and Izziah and Malchijah and Mijamin and Eleazar and Malchijah and Benaiah. (Ezra 10:25)**
- **These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)**
- **Pedaiah, one of the family, repaired a section of Jerusalem's wall.**

- After him Palal the son of Uzai did repair work in front of the Buttress and the tower that goes out from the King's house, the upper one that belongs to the Courtyard of the Guard. After him there was Pedaiah the son of **Parosh**. (**Nehemiah 3:25**)
- The head of the **Parosh** family attested to the later covenant agreeing to keep the Law of Yehowah.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (**Nehemiah 9:38**)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (**Nehemiah 10:1**)
- The heads of the people, **Parosh**, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (**Nehemiah 10:14**)
