

## ~PARTAKERS (48)

[English, participants, accomplices, accessories, contributors, assistants]

- Paul wrote that people of the nation had become **partakers** with the Jews of the precious promises of God.
- Namely, that people of the nations should be joint heirs and fellow members of the body and **partakers** with us of the promise in union with Christ Jesus through the Good News. (**Ephesians 3:6**)
- Paul warns against becoming **partakers** with greedy and unclean persons and with fornicators.
- Therefore do not become **partakers** with them. (**Ephesians 5:7**)
- Paul addresses his anointed brothers as **partakers** of the heavenly calling.
- Consequently, holy brothers, **partakers** of the heavenly calling, consider the apostle and High Priest whom we confess, Jesus. (**Hebrews 3:1**)
- Paul also shows that all such **partakers** must maintain their hold on the faith, confidence, firm to the end.
- For we actually become **partakers** of the Christ only if we make fast our hold on the confidence we had at the beginning firm to the end. (**Hebrews 3:14**)
- Paul warns also that persons who have fallen away to a habitual practice of sin cannot regain the free gift.
- For it is impossible as regards those who have once for all been enlightened, and who have tasted the heavenly free gift, and who have become **partakers** of Holy Spirit. (**Hebrews 6:4**)
- Paul also shows that partakers must accept God's discipline or else they are illegitimate children.
- But if you are without the discipline of which all have become

**partakers**, you are really illegitimate children, and not sons.  
(**Hebrews 12:8**)
