~PASHHUR 4 (38) (Pash'hur)

- The sons of Pashhur were a paternal house of priests, 1,247 of whom returned from the exile with priest Jeshua in 537 B.C.E.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The priests, the sons of Jedaiah of the house of Jeshua nine hundred and seventy-three. (Ezra 2:36)
- The sons of Pashhur, a thousand two hundred and forty-seven. (Ezra 2:38)
- The sons of Pashhur, a thousand two hundred and forty-seven. (Nehemiah 7:41)
- Six of these married foreign wives but sent them away after Ezra arrived in 468 B.C.E.
- And of the sons of Pashhur, Elioenai, Maaseiah, Ishmael, Nethanel, Jozabad and Eleasah. (Ezra 10:22)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
