

## ~PATHWAY (50)

[English, trail, path, way, lane, alleyway, conduit, corridor, passageway]

- Job showed that like a trap the wicked one has a cord hidden in his **pathway**, a catching device that will entrap him.
- A cord for him is hidden on the earth, and a catching device for him on his **pathway**. (Job 18:10)
- Job showed that no bird knows the **pathway** of things hidden deep within the earth, its treasures.
- A **pathway**, no bird of prey has known it, nor has the eye of a black kite caught sight of it. (Job 28:7)
- Job showed that Leviathan makes a shiny **pathway** as he moves through the water.
- Behind itself it makes a **pathway** shine, one would regard the watery deep as gray-headedness. (Job 41:32)
- Yehowah God had prepared a pathway for Egypt to take in their defiance against him, a **pathway** for his anger to be expressed against them.
- He proceeded to prepare a **pathway** for his anger. He did not hold back their soul from death itself, and their life he handed over even to the pestilence. (Psalms 78:50)
- The Psalmist asked for Yehowah God to cause him to tread in the **pathway** of his commandments, for he took delight in them.
- Cause me to tread in the **pathway** of your commandments, for in it I have taken delight. (Psalms 119:35)
- The **path** of the righteous ones leads to life, and following along this **pathway** means no death.
