~PAU (28) (Pa'u)

- A place in Edom, where a certain King Hadar, or Hadad, evidently had his royal residence.
- Now these are the kings who reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel. (Genesis 36:31)
- When Baalhanan son of Achbor died, Hadar began to reign instead of him, and the name of his city was Pau, and the name of his wife was Mehetabel the daughter of Matred the daughter of Mezahab. (Genesis 36:39)
- And these are the kings that reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel, Bela the son of Beor, the name of whose city was Dinhabah. (1 Chronicles 1:43)
- Eventually Baal-hanan died, and Hadad began to reign in place of him, and the name of his city was Pau, and the name of his wife was Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab. (1 Chronicles 1:50)
- The location of Pau is now unknown.
