~PEBBLE (31)

[English, stone, nugget, small rock]

- Samuel uses a hyperbole to describe the complete destruction of a city so that not even a **pebble** was left of its surrounding walls.
- And if it is into some city that he will withdraw, all Israel must also carry ropes to that city, and we shall certainly drag it down to the torrent valley, until there shall not be found there even a pebble. (2 Samuel 17:13)
- Yehowah promised to jiggle the house of Israel among the nations like shaking a seive to get all the smaller pebbles to fall out of it, until he had completely gotten rid of the insignificant ones, cleaning them out.
- For, look! I am commanding, and I will jiggle the house of Israel among all the nations, just as one jiggles the sieve, so that not a pebble falls to the earth. (Amos 9:9)
- Jesus promised a white **pebble** to the one conquering with a name written on it that only the beholder knew. This denoted a conquerer who had been declared righteous by God.
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations; To him that conquers I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white pebble, and upon the pebble a new name written which no one knows except the one receiving it. (Revelation 2:17)
