## ~PEER (59)

[English, gaze, stare, examine, look closely, rake, go over, take in, Opposite of, glance]

- The congregator **peered** down upon the sons of mankind looking for a young man in want of heart, one going to a prostitute.
- That I might peer upon the inexperienced ones. I was interested in discerning among the sons a young man in want of heart. (Proverbs 7:7)
- God's people being led away into exile, would bring a great deal of tribulation upon them. They would not understand why such hardships had come upon them, because of following their wicked leaders. They would become indignant at God and their leaders, and call down evil upon them. They would peer upward to heaven, but there would be no help coming from God, for they had refused to listen to him.
- And each one will certainly pass through the land hard pressed and hungry, and it must occur that because he is hungry and has made himself feel indignant, he will actually call down evil upon his king and upon his God and will certainly peer upward. (Isaiah 8:21)
- Yehowah God shows, that they ought not to come into the gate of his people in the day of their disaster. Also they ought not to peer at his calamity in the day of his disaster. Neither should they try to take away his wealth then, in the day of his disaster.
- You ought not to come into the gate of my people in the day of their disaster. You, even you, ought not to peer at his calamity in the day of his disaster, and you ought not to thrust out a hand upon his wealth in the day of his disaster. (Obadiah 1:13)
- That spirit revealed to these ancient prophets, that not to themselves during their own lifetimes, but to anointed Christians now living, that they were ministering these things, that have now been announced to them as Good News, through the Holy Spirit sent forth from heaven, to Peter and others. Even the angels in the heavens are intently peering into these grand expressions of the spirit.

It was revealed to them that, not to themselves, but to you, they were ministering the things that have now been announced to you through those who have declared the Good News to you with Holy Spirit sent forth from heaven. Into these very things angels are desiring to peer. (1 Peter 1:12)
