## ~PELATIAH 1 (24)

(Pel-a-ti'ah) [Yehowah Has Provided Escape]

- One of four Simeonite chieftains who led 500 men against Mount Seir and struck down the remnant of the Amalekites, likely during Hezekiah's reign.
- And these written down by their names proceeded to come in, in the days of Hezekiah the king of Judah and strike down the tents of the Hamites and the Meunim that were to be found there, so that they devoted them to destruction down to this day, and they began to dwell in their place, because there was pasturage for their flocks there. (1 Chronicles 4:41)
- And from them there were some of the sons of Simeon that went to Mount Seir, five hundred men, with Pelatiah and Neariah and Rephaiah and Uzziel the sons of Ishi at their head. (1 Chronicles 4:42)
- And they proceeded to strike down the remnant that had escaped of Amalek, and they continued to dwell there down to this day. (1 Chronicles 4:43)
