[English, Made, ideal, just right, just the thing, great, wonderful, Opposite of, wrong, flawed]

- Artaxerxes wrote to Ezra that peace should be perfected to him, thus wishing him complete peace.
- Artaxerxes, the king of kings, to Ezra the priest, the copyist of the Law of the God of the heavens; Peace be perfected. And now (Ezra 7:12)
- Dehovah's Witnesses territories are in the heart of the sea, because she trades with people worldwide who mix truth with falsehood thus making it undrinkable like seawater.
- Her builders, her Governing Body and anointed members, have made her pretty or attractive to many peoples by adhering more closely to the Bible than other islands of the sea. Therefore she stands at the entrances of the sea. Her perfected prettiness, her annual conventions, beautiful music and abundance of books to read, makes her attractive to many as does her clean, orderly and well-mannered people.
- In the heart of the seas are your territories. Your own builders have perfected your prettiness. (Ezekiel 27:4)
- Jehovah's Witnesses' military force is made up of hundreds of thousands of pioneers, courageous ones who march into enemy territory, valorous men. Her Special Pioneers man her towers with shields ready for use at a moment's notice. They perfected her prettiness by being willing to freely give their time and energies for something that they believe in. This makes her pretty in the eyes of those who are tired of crass materialism.
- The sons of Arvad, even your military force, were upon your walls all around, and valorous men were the ones that happened to be in your own towers. Their circular shields they hung up on your walls all around. They themselves perfected your prettiness. (Ezekiel 27:11)
- Jesus then asked his heavenly Father for there to be unity between him, and his Son, and between his Son, and his disciples, so

that they might all be perfected into one, for they would all live close together in heaven forever following this.

- Thus there must be unity, and shared values, and a loving attachment to one another, just as in a marriage. Thus the world would come to know that Yehowah God sent Jesus Christ forth, and that he loved Jesus' disciples, just as he loved his own Son, for they too were all to become sons of God.
- I in union with them and you in union with me, in order, that they may be perfected into one, that the world may have the knowledge that you sent me forth and that you loved them just as you loved me. (John 17:23)
- The Law Covenant appointed men as High Priests who had weakness through sinfulness. But the word of the sworn oath, which came after the Law Covenant, appoints a Son, who is perfected forever. Therefore his priesthood is strong and enduring, and it will last forever.
- For the Law appoints men High Priests having weakness, but the word of the sworn oath that came after the Law appoints a Son, who is perfected forever. (Hebrews 7:28)
- Thus Abraham's works corresponded to his faith and they were in support of them and strengthened them, and by means of his works, his faith was perfected, or made complete.
- You behold that his faith worked along with his works and by his works his faith was perfected. (James 2:22)
