~PERFECTLY (18) [English, completely, entirely, wholly, absolutely, flawlessly, rightly, Opposite of, partially]

Jesus showed that everyone who is **perfectly** instructed will be like his teacher.

• A pupil is not above his teacher, but everyone that is **perfectly** instructed will be like his teacher. (Luke 6:40)

• Paul told the members of the Sanhedrin that he had behaved with a perfectly clean conscience down to today.

 Looking intently at the Sanhedrin Paul said; Men, brothers, I have behaved before God with a perfectly clear conscience down to this day. (Acts of Apostles 23:1)
