- Abraham's servant asked Yehowah God to **perform** loving-kindness by making his way successful.
- What must occur is that the young woman to whom I shall say; Let your water jar down, please, that I may take a drink, and who will indeed say; Take a drink, and I shall also water your camels, this is the one you must assign to your servant, to Isaac, and by this let me know that you have **performed** loyal love with my master. (**Genesis 24:14**)
- Aaron spoke all the words to Pharaoh that Yehowah God had spoken to Moses, and also **performed** all the signs under the eyes of Pharaoh.
- Then Aaron spoke all the words that Yehowah had spoken to Moses, and he **performed** the signs under the eyes of the people. (**Exodus 4:30**)
- Yet though they **performed** many signs before Pharaoh of Egypt, still he just hardened his heart even more.
- And Moses and Aaron **performed** all these miracles before Pharaoh, but Yehowah would let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, so that he did not send the sons of Israel away from his land. (**Exodus 11:10**)
- Aaron and his sons **performed** a service within the holy compartment of the temple daily.
- In the tent of meeting, outside the curtain that is by the Testimony, Aaron and his sons will set it in order from evening till morning before Yehowah. It is a statute to time indefinite for their generations, to be **performed** by the sons of Israel. (**Exodus 27:21**)
- The breast portion of sacrifices was given to Aaron and his sons as a regulation to be **performed** to time indefinite.
- And it must become Aaron's and his sons by a regulation to time

indefinite to be **performed** by the sons of Israel, because it is a sacred portion, and it will become a sacred portion to be rendered by the sons of Israel. From their communion sacrifices it is their sacred portion for Yehowah. (**Exodus 29:28**)

- Moses asked how long Israel would not put their faith in him, and all the signs that Yehowah God had **performed** through him.
- Finally Yehowah said to Moses; How long will this people treat me without respect, and how long will they not put faith in me for all the signs that I **performed** in among them? (**Numbers 14:11**)
- Yehowah God reproached the faithless attitude of his people who saw his many signs he had **performed**, and yet who kept testing him ten times.
- But all the men who have been seeing my glory and my signs that I have **performed** in Egypt and in the wilderness and yet kept testing me these ten times, and have not listened to my voice. (**Numbers 14:22**)
- For it is Yehowah our God who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slaves, and who **performed** these great signs before our eyes and who kept guarding us in all the way in which we walked and among all the peoples through the midst of whom we passed. (**Joshua 24:17**)
- Saul said that no man should be put to death, for that day Yehowah God had **performed** a great salvation.
- However, Saul said; Not a man should be put to death on this day, because today Yehowah has **performed** salvation in Israel. (**1 Samuel 11:13**)
- But the people said to Saul; Is Jonathan to die, who has **performed** this great salvation in Israel? It is unthinkable! As Yehowah is alive, not as much as a single hair of his head will fall to the earth, for it was with God that he worked this day. With that the people redeemed Jonathan, and he did not die. (**1 Samuel 14:45**)
- David struck the Philistine Goliath down and **performed** a great salvation for Israel that day.

- And he proceeded to put his soul in his palm and strike the Philistine down, so that Yehowah **performed** a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it, and you gave way to rejoicing. So why should you sin against innocent blood in having David put to death for nothing? (**1 Samuel 19:5**)
- Eleazar rose up and **performed** a great salvation by striking down many Philistines and cleaving them with his sword.
- He it was that rose up and kept striking down the Philistines until his hand wearied and his hand kept cleaving to the sword, so that Yehowah **performed** a great salvation on that day, and as for the people, they returned behind him only to strip those struck down. (**2 Samuel 23:10**)
- But he took his stand in the middle of the tract and delivered it and kept striking down the Philistines, so that Yehowah **performed** a great salvation. (**2 Samuel 23:12**)
- After the temple dedication by Solomon the people went home rejoicing over all the goodness that Yehowah God had **performed** for his servant David, and for his people.
- On the eighth day he sent the people away, and they began to bless the king and to go to their homes, rejoicing and feeling merry of heart over all the goodness that Yehowah had **performed** for David his servant and for Israel his people. (**1 Kings 8:66**)
- And on the twenty-third day of the seventh month he sent the people away to their homes, joyful and feeling good at heart over the goodness that Yehowah had **performed** toward David and toward Solomon and toward Israel his people. (**2 Chronicles 7:10**)
- Israel was sent forth into exile because they neither listened nor **performed** Yehowah God's commandments.
- Over the fact that they had not listened to the voice of Yehowah their God, but kept overstepping his covenant, even all that Moses the servant of Yehowah had commanded. They neither listened nor **performed**. (**2 Kings 18:12**)

- The writer counsels Israel to remember the wonderful acts that Yehowah God had previously **performed** for his people Israel.
- Remember his wonderful acts that he has **performed**, his miracles and the judicial decisions of his mouth. (**1 Chronicles 16:12**)
- Nehemiah showed that Israel failed to listen to their God and they did not **perform** his Law Covenant, also they forgot all his wonderful acts that he had **performed** for them.
- So they refused to listen, and they did not remember your wonderful acts that you **performed** with them, but they hardened their neck and appointed a head to return to their servitude in Egypt. But you are a God of acts of forgiveness, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abundant in loving-kindness, and you did not leave them. (**Nehemiah 9:17**)
- As for our kings, our princes, our priests and our forefathers, they have not **performed** your Law, nor paid attention to your commandments or to your testimonies with which you bore witness against them. (**Nehemiah 9:34**)
- Nehemiah himself asked Yehowah God to remember him for the acts of loving-kindness, that he had **performed** toward Yehowah God's people.
- Do remember me, O my God, concerning this, and do not wipe out my acts of loving-kindness that I have **performed** in connection with the house of my God and the guardianship of it. (**Nehemiah 13:14**)
- Queen Vashti was removed from being queen because she failed to **perform** the order of the king.
- According to Law what is to be done with Queen Vashti because she has not **performed** the saying of King Ahasuerus by means of the court officials? (**Esther 1:15**)
- On the day when the enemies of the Jews were set to destroy them, they **performed** a great turn around due to the further order of the king, and destroyed their enemies.
- And in the twelfth month, that is, the month of Adar, on the

thirteenth day of it, when the king's word and his Law came due to be **performed**, on the day for which the enemies of the Jews had waited to domineer over them, there was even a turning to the contrary, in that the Jews themselves domineered over those hating them. (**Esther 9:1**)

- The Psalmist showed that his forefathers had taught Israelites about the many wonderful saving acts Yehowah God had **performed** for them in the past.
- O God, with our ears we have heard, our forefathers themselves have recounted to us the activity that you **performed** in their days, in the days of long ago. (**Psalms 44:1**)
- Those who walk in Yehowah's way, he will always adjudge as peaceful, because the works that they follow closely, are his pattern of healthful words laid out for us in his word of truth, the Bible. Therefore, he has figuratively **performed the work for us**, by showing us the clear path, **the righteous way**, and why
- O Yehowah, you will adjudge peace to us, because even all our works you have **performed** for us. (**Isaiah 26:12**)
- The nations roundabout have tried to arrest and persecute some of Jehovah's Witnesses in the past. However, those nations responded favorably to Yehowah's counsel to them to stop persecuting his sons. Jehovah's Witnesses are more turbulent than them for they will not take counsel from Yehowah and stop harming his spiritual sons.
- They exercise the same manner of worldly injustices by refusing to hear clear evidence in behalf of newly anointed ones. They thus act worse even than the world, which only turns a deaf ear to spiritual truth, when they call all material apostasy when they haven't even taken the time to read it. Yehowah is a just and righteous judge and he will not tolerate it any longer.
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that you people were more turbulent than the nations that are all around you, in my statutes you did not walk and my judicial decisions you did not perform, but according to the judicial decisions of the nations that are all around you, you **performed**, did you not? (**Ezekiel 5:7**)

- When Babylon conquered Tyre the people of Tyre took the wealth of the city and removed it to another city one-half mile out to sea on an island. Therefore when the Babylonians took the city there was no real financial reward in it for them. The island city nearby was safe from them for they had no fleet of ships to use to attack it.
- Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar himself, the king of Babylon, made his military force perform a great service against Tyre. Every head was one made bald, and every shoulder was one rubbed bare. But as for wages, there proved to be none for him and his military force from Tyre for the service that he had **performed** against her. ([Ezekiel 29:18](#))
- The **Greater Nebuchadnezzar**, has been gathering a people throughout this generation. To this people, and in fact to all the world of mankind, **his heart wishes for peace** toward all of them. Through him, during this time of the end, Yehowah God has **performed** great wonders, and he has published them to the most distant parts of the earth, through the preaching of the Good News of the Kingdom.
- The signs and wonders that the Most High God has **performed** with me, it has seemed good to me to declare. ([Daniel 4:2](#))
- When the Sabbath arrived he entered into the local synagogue where he had been reared and started to teach there. The majority of the people there were simply astounded by his teachings that they were listening to. They wondered aloud; Where did this man get these things? Others asked; Why should this man be given this wisdom and all these powerful works? And so they were in a quandary over him.
- When it became Sabbath, he started teaching in the synagogue, and the greater number of those listening were astounded and said; Where did this man get these things? And why should this wisdom have been given this man, and such powerful works be **performed** through his hands? ([Mark 6:2](#))
- Mary then continued to praise this wonderful God, for he had **performed** mightily with his arm many times in the past, and he had scattered those who had haughty hearts before him.
- He has **performed** mightily with his arm, he has scattered abroad those who are haughty in the intention of their hearts. ([Luke 1:51](#))

- So he blessed Yehowah the God of Israel, because he had turned his attention to his people Israel, and **performed** deliverance toward his people.
- Blessed be Yehowah the God of Israel, because he has turned his attention and **performed** deliverance toward his people. (**Luke 1:68**)
- Now when Herod saw Jesus he rejoiced greatly for he had been wanting to meet him for a long time, because of having heard so many things about him, and he wanted to see a sign **performed** by him in his presence.
- When Herod saw Jesus he rejoiced greatly, for over a considerable time he was wanting to see him because of having heard about him, and he was hoping to see some sign **performed** by him. (**Luke 23:8**)
- This was Jesus' first miracle, that he **performed** in Cana of Galilee, as the beginning of his many signs, and through it, he made his glory manifest to his disciples, who then put their faith in him.
- Jesus **performed** this in Cana of Galilee as the beginning of his signs, and he made his glory manifest, and his disciples put their faith in him. (**John 2:11**)
- So then, this was the second sign Jesus **performed** when he came out of Judea, the first being turning the water into wine in Cana of Galilee before he left for Judea.
- Again this was the second sign Jesus **performed** when he came out of Judea into Galilee. (**John 4:54**)
- So when people began to see the glorious signs he was **performing**, they began to say about him, that he must be the prophet that the scriptures had foretold was coming into the world.
- Hence when the men saw the signs he **performed**, they began to say; This is for a certainty the prophet that was to come into the world. (**John 6:14**)
- So Jesus said to them; One deed I **performed** and now, you are all wondering.

- In answer Jesus said to them; One deed I **performed**, and you are all wondering. (**John 7:21**)
- Still there were many within the crowds that were putting their faith in him, and they reasoned among themselves, that the Christ surely would not come forth with more signs from God, than this man had **performed**, for the works Jesus did, spoke volumes to reasoning people, that he was God's representative.
- Still, many of the crowd put faith in him, and they commenced saying; When the Christ arrives, he will not perform more signs than this man has **performed**, will he? (**John 7:31**)
- So on this account many who heard this witness, also joined in with the crowd who gathered together to praise his entrance into Jerusalem.
- On this account the crowd, because they heard he had **performed** this sign, also met him. (**John 12:18**)
- Yet even though Jesus had **performed** so many signs before the people, and helped so many through his fine works, still they were not putting faith in him.
- But although he had **performed** so many signs before them, they were not putting faith in him. (**John 12:37**)
- John now adds for our benefit today, that Jesus **performed** many other signs, that are not recorded in his Gospel, or for that matter in any of the other Gospel accounts.
- To be sure, Jesus **performed** many other signs also before the disciples, which are not written down in this scroll. (**John 20:30**)
- From there they sailed off to Syrian Antioch, the place from which they had begun this journey, through the undeserved-kindness of Yehowah God.
- And from there they sailed off for Antioch, where they had been entrusted to the undeserved kindness of God for the work they had fully **performed**. (**Acts of Apostles 14:26**)
- A further unnamed reference to a woman known only as Mary is made, for her many labors **performed** in Paul's behalf. Thus Paul

shows many times, that thankfulness is a part of the Christian personality, and not only thankfulness to God.

- Greet Mary, who has **performed** many labors for you. (**Romans 16:6**)
- Paul greets two women who have labored with him in the preaching work, Tryphaena and Tryphosa. Paul also greets Persis another woman who is beloved to him, and who has **performed** many labors for the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Greet Tryphaena and Tryphosa, women who are working hard in the Lord. Greet Persis our beloved one, for she **performed** many labors in the Lord. (**Romans 16:12**)
- By our relationship to him, we were circumcised by the Holy Spirit, which cut away the resistance of our hearts to the doing of God's will, making us sensitive to the doing of God's will. Also this stripping off of our body of flesh, that surrounds the spirit being, that we really are inside, is the circumcision, that belongs to the Christ, and it is **performed** without hands.
- By relationship with him you were also circumcised with a circumcision **performed** without hands by the stripping off the body of the flesh, by the circumcision that belongs to the Christ. (**Colossians 2:11**)
- This change was given to them through no works of righteousness, that they had **performed**, but came through God's mercy and undeserved kindness. He then brought his anointed sons to birth through a bath in the Holy Spirit, similar to the breaking of the waters in a human birth, one that brought us to life in the spirit, thus making our lives anew through Holy Spirit.
- Owing to no works in righteousness that we had **performed**, but according to his mercy he saved us through the bath that brought us to life and through the making of us new by Holy Spirit. (**Titus 3:5**)
- Jesus told his disciples to keep on the watch for they would not know the day and hour of his coming. The ones who were watching would then gain the privilege of serving the food to all his domestics. They needed to become watchful for their deeds before Yehowah God were not yet fully **performed**.

- **Become watchful, and strengthen the things remaining that were ready to die, for I have not found your deeds fully **performed** before my God. (**Revelation 3:2**)**

- **The wild beast will be caught in its lies and injustices, and its false prophet image will be shown up for what it really is, just another excuse for men to wickedly rule over one another. Its destruction will clearly mark it as a false prophet, for it said; I sit a queen and I shall never see mourning.**

- **Both the wild beast, Jehovah's Witnesses, and their claim to be the incoming kingdom of God, will be destroyed suddenly while they are a fully functioning organization, while still alive. They will then go out of existence eternally as an organization. The Lake that burns with fire and sulphur means the second death. They will not return as an organization.**

- **And the wild beast was caught, and along with it the false prophet that **performed** in front of it the signs with which he misled those who received the mark of the wild beast and those who render worship to its image. While still alive, they both were hurled into the fiery lake that burns with sulphur. (**Revelation 19:20**)**
