[English, puzzled, at a loss, confused, mystified, confounded, baffled, thrown, bewildered]

- When first seeing the writing on the wall of his castle Belshazzar was frightened and very much perplexed.
- Consequently King Belshazzar was very much frightened and his complexion was changing within him, and his grandees were perplexed. (Daniel 5:9)
- Festus said that he had asked Paul if he wanted to go to Jerusalem to be judged over these perplexing matters.
- So, being perplexed as to the dispute over these matters, I proceeded to ask if he would like to go to Jerusalem and there be judged concerning these matters. (Acts of Apostles 25:20)
- Paul wrote that we are perplexed, but not with absolutely no way out.
- We are pressed in every way, but not cramped beyond movement, we are perplexed, but not absolutely with no way out. (2 Corinthians 4:8)
- Paul was perplexed over the Galatians being so quickly turned to another Good News other than the one he preached.
- But I could wish to be present with you just now and to speak in a different way, because I am perplexed over you. (Galatians 4:20)
