[English, bewilderment, confound, confusion, bafflement, puzzlement, mystification, Opposite of, **understanding**]

- Herod was in great **perplexity** because of some saying that John the Baptist had been raised up from the dead.
- Now Herod the district ruler heard of all the things happening, and he was in great **perplexity** because of its being said by some that John had been raised up from the dead. (**Luke 9:7**)
- The disciples went early to the tomb of Jesus, but were in **perplexity** over finding the stone rolled away and by seeing two men in flashing clothing.
- While they were in **perplexity** over this, look! Two men in flashing clothing stood by them. (**Luke 24:4**)
- Those gathered together in Jerusalem for the Festival of pentecost were in **perplexity** over hearing Galileans speaking in their native tongues about the glorious things of God.
- Yes, they were all astonished and were in **perplexity**, saying one to another; What does this thing purport to be? (**Acts of Apostles 2:12**)
- Peter, after seeing a vision, was in great **perplexity** as to what the vision meant.
- Now while Peter was in great **perplexity** inwardly over what the vision he had seen might mean, look! The men dispatched by Cornelius had made inquiries for Simon's house and stood there at the gate. (**Acts of Apostles 10:17**)
