

~PERSUASION (57)

- Their argument was that Paul, was leading men off to a different **persuasion** in their worship of God. This Paul certainly was doing, but he had sound scriptural backing to do so, also the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Saying; Contrary to the Law this person leads men to another **persuasion** in worshipping God. ([Acts of Apostles 18:13](#))
- So entering into the synagogue there in Ephesus, Paul spoke with boldness for three months, giving talks often, and using **persuasion** concerning the Kingdom of God from the scriptures.
- Entering into the synagogue, he spoke with boldness for three months, giving talks and using **persuasion** concerning the kingdom of God. ([Acts of Apostles 19:8](#))
- So they arranged to spend a day with him, and they came forth in great numbers to where he was staying, which was a private home. So there, he explained the matter to them, bearing thorough witness to them concerning the Kingdom of God. He also used **persuasion** with them concerning Jesus, showing how Jesus' life course fulfilled many of the prophecies of the Law Covenant of Moses, and things written in the Prophets, this he did throughout that entire day.
- They now arranged for a day with him, and they came in greater numbers to him in his lodging place. And he explained the matter to them by bearing thorough witness concerning the kingdom of God and by using **persuasion** with them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening. ([Acts of Apostles 28:23](#))
- Paul now shows, that all Christians who are anointed ones are being led by the spirit of God, for they are in the New Covenant, and have received an anointing from God. They have died to the Law Covenant, through undeserved kindness, and they walk in a new way, to the same course of obeying the Law Covenant's fine tenets and principles, but through love of the spirit, and not by means of a written code, that condemns to death.

- This sort of **persuasion** is not from the One calling you. (**Galatians 5:8**)
