## ~PHILETUS (15) (Phi-le'tus) [Beloved, Worthy of Love]

- A First-Century apostate from Christianity whom Paul mentions with Hymenaeus. Paul describes Philetus and Hymenaeus as false teachers concerning the resurrection and as subverters of the faith.
- And their word will spread like gangrene. Hymenaeus and Philetus are of that number. (2 Timothy 2:17)
- These very men have deviated from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already occurred, and they are subverting the faith of some. (2 Timothy 2:18)
