~PIERCED (225)

[English, stabbed, cut, sliced, sliced open, penetrated, pricked, perforated, punctured]

- Phineas went into the tent and pierced through the Israelite man, and Cozbi the daughter of Midian.
- Then he went after the man of Israel into the vaulted tent and pierced both of them through, the man of Israel and the woman through her genital parts. At that the scourge was halted from upon the sons of Israel. (Numbers 25:8)
- Jael pierced through Sisera with a tent pin to his temple.
- Her hand to the tent pin she then thrust out, and her right hand to the mallet of hard workers. And she hammered Sisera, she pierced his head through, and she broke apart and cut up his temples. (Judges 5:26)
- Job shows that the hand of Yehowah God can pierce through the gliding serpent.
- By his wind he has polished up heaven itself, this hand has pierced the gliding serpent. (Job 26:13)
- The Psalmist shows that the pains of those pierced through by Yehowah God they kept recounting.
- For the one whom you yourself have struck they have pursued, and the pains of those pierced by you they keep recounting. (Psalms 69:26)
- The Psalmist bemoaned that he was afflicted and poor and his heart had been pierced within him.
- For I am afflicted and poor, and my heart itself has been pierced within me. (Psalms 109:22)
- When Yehowah's denunciation comes through the hands of all the nations, it will come in fury and scatter all the religions of the earth. They will not care about ones guilt or innocence, but everyone then identifying himself with religion, will be pierced through. The

forces of the United Nations, will then sweep throughout the earth, leaving all religion devastated in its wake.

- Every one that is found will be pierced through, and every one that is caught in the sweep will fall by the sword. (Isaiah 13:15)
- The arm of Yehowah, is his spirit, through which he accomplishes all of his wonderful works. In times past he used his spirit to bring up a vast mixed company out of Egypt. He pierced the great sea monster, by splitting the Red Sea, allowing Israel escape and salvation.
- Today by his revealing of the second sign of Moses, he has bared his mighty arm again, showing that he is ready to get to work with his spirit, and his word the Bible, to destroy this wicked system.
- Awake, awake, clothe yourself with strength, O arm of Yehowah! Awake as in the days of long ago, as during the generations of times long past. Are you not the one that broke Rahab to pieces, that pierced the sea monster? (Isaiah 51:9)
- Jesus was being pierced through for the transgressions of the nation of Israel and crushed for their errors.
- But he was being pierced for our transgression, he was being crushed for our errors. The chastisement meant for our peace was upon him, and because of his wounds there has been a healing for us. (Isaiah 53:5)
- Yehowah now illustrates, how bad their situation is. If the Babylonian army was defeated and there remained only men pierced through within it, then those men would rise up and burn their city, there would be no escape.
- For if you men had struck down all the military force of the Chaldeans who are fighting you and there remained over among them men pierced through, they would each one in his tent rise up and actually burn this city with fire. (Jeremiah 37:10)
- Her unprepared army would fall lifeless in her public squares and pierced through in her streets. The battle would be over in a flash of activity, and her unprepared forces would all fall, if they attempted to fight.
- And they must fall slain in the land of the Chaldeans and pierced

through in her streets. (Jeremiah 51:4)

- Yehowah will turn his attention to Babylon and all of her sects, and bring them, and all of her idol gods, to ruin. All those who try to support these graven images, will then fall beside them, for the true God deserves honor and respect, and he will no longer tolerate any rivals. There is one true God Yehowah, and no one else is deserving of his praise, as the maker of heaven and earth.
- Therefore, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will turn my attention upon her graven images, and throughout all her land the pierced one will groan. (Jeremiah 51:52)
- Jeremiah felt that those who were slain by the sword and pierced through suddenly fared better than those who starved when Jerusalem fell to the Babylonians.
- Better have those slain with the sword proved to be than those slain by famine, because these pine away, pierced through for lack of the produce of the open field. (Lamentations 4:9)
- Still other daughters of majestic nations that speak from the grave are Meshech and Tubal, sons of Japheth, Noah's son.
- These ones speak from the grave because they all ignored Yehowah's retribution for their course of action. They all want to dominate and to terrorize defenseless people like their father, Satan, and it will no longer be tolerated.
- There is where Meshech and Tubal and all her crowd are. Her burial places are round about him. All of them are uncircumcised, pierced through by the sword, because they have caused their terror in the land of those alive. (Ezekiel 32:26)
- Habakkuk now reveals that Yehowah God pierced the heads of the warriors of the nations, when they moved tempestuously to scatter his anointed one. At that time their high glee was just as those bent on devouring an afflicted one, when that one was out of sight of others, and had no other helper.
- With his own rods you pierced the head of his warriors when they moved tempestuously to scatter me. Their high glee was as of those bent on devouring an afflicted one in a place of

concealment. (Habakkuk 3:14)

- Also then, Yehowah God will pour out upon the house of David, his spirit anointed Christian sons, and upon the inhabitants of New Jerusalem, his Great Crowd, the spirit of favor and entreaties. Then they will look to the one whom they pierced through, and they will certainly wail over him as over a firstborn only son. Then also there will be a bitter lamentation over him, as when there is a bitter lamentation over the firstborn son, for what they have done to Yehowah God's Messiah.
- And I will pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of favor and entreaties, and they will certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they will certainly wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there will be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (Zechariah 12:10)
- But all the others just said; Let him be. They said that they wanted to see if Elijah actually would come to save him, but they were heartless men who just wanted to see him die. Then another man, a soldier, took a spear and pierced his side, and immediately blood and water came out, for he was dead.
- But the rest of them said; Let him be! Let us see whether Elijah comes to save him. Another man took a spear and pierced his side, and blood and water came out. (Matthew 27:49)
- Also another scripture was fulfilled that says, that they would look to the one that they pierced.
- And, again, a different scripture says: They will look to the One whom they pierced. (John 19:37)
- Clouds are a way of hiding sunlight. The sun symbolizes Yehowah God's presence symbolically in the Bible record. Coming on the clouds means, that Christ comes with God's full blessing. In the same manner as a cloud is generated from the Sun's energy, so too Christ comes forth from Yehowah.
- Look! He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, and those who pierced him, and all the tribes of the earth will

beat themselves in grief because of him. Yes, Amen. (Revelation 1:7)
