## ~PILLAGED (63)

[English, plundered, sacked, robbed, stole, embezzled, despoiled]

- Yehowah God kept giving his people over to pillagers when they disobeyed him.
- You keep making us turn back from the adversary, and the very ones intensely hating us have pillaged for themselves. (Psalms 44:10)
- The Psalmist bemoaned that all those passing along had pillaged Israel, he had become a reproach other his neighbor nations.
- All those passing along the way have pillaged him, he has become a reproach to his neighbors. (Psalms 89:41)
- It will not be a time to offer resistance. If anyone is meant for captivity, he goes away into captivity. If anyone will kill with the sword, he must be killed with the sword. Here is where it means the endurance and faith of the holy ones. Resistance will be fatal and futile for it is Yehowah's express will to bring an end to all religion.
- And their very children will be dashed to pieces before their eyes. Their houses will be pillaged, and their own wives will be raped. (Isaiah 13:16)
- Today his people allow themselves to be pillaged and plundered spiritually by the clergy classes, who take this delight away from them, and then tell them; We will tell you everything you need to do in true worship.
- All of the sects of Christendom and Judaism have trapped them in holes, of limited traditional understanding, and in houses of detention where they are kept from the glorious word of truth. All of the clergy are the same, they plunder them without a deliverer.
- But it is a people plundered and pillaged, all of them being trapped in the holes, and in the houses of detention they have been kept hidden. They have come to be for plunder without a deliverer, for pillage without anyone to say; Bring back! (Isaiah 42:22)

- Then he shall certainly gather all the nations of the earth together against Jerusalem, the collective peoples who worship the God of the Bible. Then the nations will capture that city worldwide, and their houses will be pillaged, and their women will be raped. Then the half of that city must go into exile, but as for the remaining ones of that city, they will not be cut off from that city.
- And I shall certainly gather all the nations against Jerusalem for the war, and the city will actually be captured and the houses be pillaged, and the women themselves will be raped. And half of the city must go forth into the exile, but as for the remaining ones of the people, they will not be cut off from the city. (Zechariah 14:2)
