## ~PILLAGERS (32)

[English, Those who, plunder, sack, rob, steal, embezzle, despoil]

- When Yehowah's anger blazed against his people for their disobedience, he would give them over to the pillagers.
- At this Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel, so that he gave them into the hands of the pillagers, and they began to pillage them, and he proceeded to sell them into the hand of their enemies round about, and they were no longer able to stand before their enemies. (Judges 2:14)
- Consequently Yehowah rejected all the seed of Israel and kept afflicting them and giving them into the hand of pillagers, until he had cast them away from before him. (2 Kings 17:20)
- Then when they repented and accepted his discipline he would deliver them by means of the judges from these pillagers.
- So Yehowah would raise up judges, and they would save them out of the hand of their pillagers. (Judges 2:16)
- And the force of pillagers would sally forth from the camp of the Philistines in three bands. The one band would turn to the road to Ophrah, to the land of Shual. (1 Samuel 13:17)
- Then a trembling occurred in the camp in the field and among all the people of the outpost, and the force of pillagers trembled, even they, and the earth began quaking, and it developed into a trembling from God. (1 Samuel 14:15)
