

## ~PLEADING (30)

[English, insistent, importunate, persuasive, earnest, beseeching, demanding, Opposite of, **half-hearted**]

- Jeremiah speaking for Yehowah showed that they had no one who would **plead** for their recovery from sickness and that their spiritual sickness was not recoverable, later the entire land was sent into exile.
- There is no one **pleading** your cause, for your ulcer. There are no means of healing, no mending, for you. (**Jeremiah 30:13**)
- Paul was willing to expose himself to many dangers to accomplish Yehowah will for him, but at times others had to hold him back in his own self interests.
- Even some of the commissioners of festivals and games, who were friendly to him, sent to him and began **pleading** for him not to risk himself in the theater. (**Acts of Apostles 19:31**)
- Yehowah knows that meaning of the **pleadings** of the spirit as it searches our hearts so that even if earth ourselves do not know what to ask for we will still receive it from him.
- Yet he who searches the hearts knows what the meaning of the spirit is, because it is **pleading** in accord with God for holy ones. (**Romans 8:27**)
