[English, begs, beseeches, implores, entreats, appeals, impurtunes, supplicates, prays]

- Job speaks of Yehowah as one who pleads the cause of peoples.
- For by them he pleads the cause of peoples, he gives food in abundance. (Job 36:31)
- The Holy Spirit pleads with our spirits with groanings unuttered to become like God in all our ways and dealings.
- In like manner the spirit also joins in with help for our weakness, for the problem of what we should pray for as we need to we do not know, but the spirit itself pleads for us with groanings unuttered. (Romans 8:26)
- Who will condemn Christians? Paul thus asks, for it is Christ in heaven at God's right hand, who pleads for them.
- Who is he that will condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died, yes, rather the one who was raised up from the dead, who is on the right hand of God, who also pleads for us. (Romans 8:34)
- Elijah pleaded with God against Israel for their badness was abundant.
- God did not reject his people, whom he first recognized. Why, do you not know what the Scripture says in connection with Elijah, as he pleads with God against Israel? (Romans 11:2)
