

~PLEADS (35)

[English, begs, beseeches, implores, entreats, appeals, impertunes, supplicates, prays]

- Job speaks of Yehowah as one who **pleads** the cause of peoples.
- For by them he **pleads** the cause of peoples, he gives food in abundance. (**Job 36:31**)
- The Holy Spirit **pleads** with our spirits with groanings unuttered to become like God in all our ways and dealings.
- In like manner the spirit also joins in with help for our weakness, for the problem of what we should pray for as we need to we do not know, but the spirit itself **pleads** for us with groanings unuttered. (**Romans 8:26**)
- Who will condemn Christians? Paul thus asks, for it is Christ in heaven at God's right hand, who **pleads** for them.
- Who is he that will condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died, yes, rather the one who was raised up from the dead, who is on the right hand of God, who also **pleads** for us. (**Romans 8:34**)
- Elijah **pleaded** with God against Israel for their badness was abundant.
- God did not reject his people, whom he first recognized. Why, do you not know what the Scripture says in connection with Elijah, as he **pleads** with God against Israel? (**Romans 11:2**)
