~PLEASANTNESS (80)

[English, agreeable nature, lovliness, appeal, Opposite of, unpleasantness]

- Job showed, that if men obey and serve Yehowah God, that they will end their years in pleasantness.
- If they obey and serve, they will finish their days in what is good and their years in pleasantness. (Job 36:11)
- The Psalmist showed, that Yehowah would cause him to know the path of life, for rejoicing to time indefinite and pleasantness were at his right hand forever.
- You will cause me to know the path of life. Rejoicing to satisfaction is with your face, there is pleasantness at your right hand forever. (Psalms 16:11)
- The Psalmist asked for only one thing from Yehowah God to dwell in his house of worship forever, there to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah God, and look with appreciation upon his beautiful temple.
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah. It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the house of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (Psalms 27:4)
- The Psalmist asked for the pleasantness of Yehowah God to prove to be upon his people Israel and to firmly establish them.
- And let the pleasantness of Yehowah our God prove to be upon us, and the work of our hands do you firmly establish upon us. Yes, the work of our hands, do you firmly establish it. (Psalms 90:17)
- The ways of wisdom and knowledge are ways of pleasantness and of peace.
- Its ways are ways of pleasantness, and all its roadways are peace. (Proverbs 3:17)

- So Yehowah God stepped in, and proceeded to shepherd the flock meant for the killing, in behalf of the afflicted ones of that flock, that these wicked shepherds had been mistreating. So Yehowah God took to himself two staffs to do this shepherding work among them, the one staff called Pleasantness, and the second one called Union, and he proceeded to shepherd their flock. This, because Yehowah's true ways are peace and unity, not the way that their false religious shepherds have been dividing them off into thousands of disparate sects within Christendom, to use them for their own personal gain.
- And I proceeded to shepherd the flock meant for the killing, in your behalf, O afflicted ones of the flock. So I took for myself two staffs. The one I called Pleasantness, and the other I called Union, and I went shepherding the flock. (Zechariah 11:7)
- So next Yehowah shows, that he would take his shepherding staff the one called **Pleasantness** and cut it into pieces, for he would no more try to make them love peace, which is his way. He also would break his covenant with them, that he had concluded with all the peoples.
- So I took my staff Pleasantness and cut it to pieces, in order to break my covenant that I had concluded with all the peoples. (Zechariah 11:10)
