

~PLUNDERING (210)

[English, predatory, preying, maurauding, aggressive, robbing, stealing, looting, pillaging, raiding, ransacking]

- Jacob's sons fatally wounded the men of Shechem and went to **plundering** their city because he had raped their sister.
- The other sons of Jacob attacked the fatally wounded men and went **plundering** the city, because they had defiled their sister. (Genesis 34:27)
- Asa went pursuing the Ethiopians toward Gerar and went to **plundering** these cities, for there was much **plunder** within them.
- Further, they struck all the cities round about Gerar, for the dread of Yehowah had come to be upon them, and they went **plundering** all the cities, for there happened to be much to plunder in them. (2 Chronicles 14:14)
- Jehoshaphat and his people went to **plundering** the spoil for three days for it was abundant.
- So Jehoshaphat and his people came to plunder the spoil on them, and they got to find among them in abundance both goods and clothing and desirable articles, and they went stripping them off for themselves until they could carry no more. And it came to be three days that they were **plundering** the spoil, for it was abundant. (2 Chronicles 20:25)
- False religion's fall will be sudden, as in one night, and so will be the fall of the nations. Likewise all of those who take up the sword, the nations and their armies, will also perish by means of the sword. Thus both groups, who have pillaged and **plundered** God's people down through time, will be brought to a sudden and untimely end.
- At evening time, why, look! There is sudden terror. Before morning, it is no more. This is the share of those pillaging us, and the lot belonging to those **plundering** us. (Isaiah 17:14)
- Their condition is bad, but Yehowah has affection for his people who are in a covenant with him and have served him faithfully in the past. He will fight for them and bring about recuperation.

- Yehowah will then turn their enemies against one another, those devouring will be devoured, and those plundering others will themselves be **plundered**, and this will bring about a recuperation for Yehowah's people.

- Therefore all those devouring you will themselves be devoured, and as for all your adversaries, into captivity they will all of them go. And those pillaging you will certainly come to be for pillaging, and all those **plundering** you I shall give over to plundering. (**Jeremiah 30:16**)

- Since they had performed a service for Yehowah in destroying the city of Tyre but were never compensated, he then gave them Egypt as a reward, which was abundant in wealth. The **tyrants of the nations today, are the terrorists** and after they destroy Tyre they will be rewarded by being permitted to **plunder** the remainder of this Egyptian like system of things.

- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am giving to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon the land of Egypt, and he must carry off its wealth and make a big spoil of it and do a great deal of **plundering** of it, and it must become wages for his military force. (**Ezekiel 29:19**)

- The **spoil**, that **Satan, Gog of Magog** will be after, is a **people who will follow his way of dominating over and plundering others of mankind**. He will see all of the lands that his wicked system left devastated at the end of the thousand years, now re-inhabited and the inhabitants enjoying peace, health and prosperity. They will be dwelling in the center of earth for their lives will be firmly focused on doing the will of Yehowah, earth's King.

- It will be to get a big spoil and to do much **plundering**, in order to turn your hand back upon devastated places reinhabited and upon a people gathered together out of the nations, one that is accumulating wealth and property, those who are dwelling in the center of the earth. (**Ezekiel 38:12**)

- Those remnants of the famous trading nations of old will question Gog as to his motives. Have you congregated your congregation to get material wealth like gold and silver, to **plunder** the land and obtain its wealth and property? What really is your reason for coming in against the open rural country?

- Sheba and Dedan and the merchants of Tarshish and all its maned young lions, they will say to you; Is it to get a big spoil that you are coming in? Is it to do much **plundering** that you have congregated your congregation, in order to carry off silver and gold, to take wealth and property, to get a very great spoil? (**Ezekiel 38:13**)

- There will be enough of this fire wood for them to light fires for seven years, which would indicate a large force coming up against them. Yehowah's sense of justice will cause him to turn the scales on these **plunderers** who would set upon innocent people. Now these wicked ones and all of their possessions will become spoil and plunder for the very ones that they set out to plunder. They will be brought to ruin by Yehowah's mighty hand.

- And they will not carry sticks of wood from the field, nor will they gather firewood out of the forests, for with the armor they will light fires. And they will certainly make spoil of those who had been making spoil of them, and plunder those who had been **plundering** them, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 39:10**)

- Those one having **insight**, **today is the Son of Man**, and any who follow in the course he counsels. They will be made to stumble by opposition to the Messiah's teachings by the sword, fire and plundering for some days.

- And as regards those having insight among the people, they will impart understanding to the many. And they will certainly be made to stumble by sword and by flame, by captivity and by **plundering**, for some days. (**Daniel 11:33**)

- At that time these Hebrew Christians expressed sympathy for those imprisoned ones, and let their possessions go joyfully to those who wanted to **plunder** them, knowing that they had a superior hope ahead of them, an abiding inheritance.

- For you both expressed sympathy for those in prison and joyfully took the **plundering** of your belongings, knowing you yourselves have a better and an abiding possession. (**Hebrews 10:34**)
