(Po'che-reth-haz-ze-ba'im)

- Head of a family whose descendants were among the sons of the servants of Solomon returning from the exile under the leadership of Zerubbabel.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The sons of the servants of Solomon, the sons of Sotai, the sons of Sophereth, the sons of Peruda. (Ezra 2:55)
- The sons of Shephatiah, the sons of Hattil, the sons of Pocherethhazzebaim, the sons of Ami. (Ezra 2:57)
- The sons of Shephatiah, the sons of Hattil, the sons of Pocherethhazzebaim, the sons of Amon. (Nehemiah 7:59)
