

~POLLUTE (23)

[English, contaminate, poison, infect, spoil, litter, make dirty, corrupt, defile, Opposite of, **clean**]

- Unatoned for bloodshed would **pollute** the land and **only the blood of the one spilling blood could ever atone for the spilling of blood upon the land.**
- And you must not **pollute** the land in which you are, because it is blood that **pollutes** the land, and for the land there may be no atonement respecting the blood that has been spilled upon it except by the blood of the one spilling it. (**Numbers 35:33**)
- Daniel and his three companions determined at heart not to **pollute** themselves with the kings delicacies.
- But Daniel determined in his heart that he would not **pollute** himself with the delicacies of the king and with his drinking wine. And he kept requesting of the principal court official that he might not **pollute** himself. (**Daniel 1:8**)
