~POLLUTE (23)

[English, contaminate, poison, infect, spoil, litter, make dirty, corrupt, defile, Opposite of, clean]

- Unatoned for bloodshed would pollute the land and only the blood of the one spilling blood could ever atone for the spilling of blood upon the land.
- And you must not pollute the land in which you are, because it is blood that pollutes the land, and for the land there may be no atonement respecting the blood that has been spilled upon it except by the blood of the one spilling it. (Numbers 35:33)
- Daniel and his three companions determined at heart not to pollute themselves with the kings delicacies.
- But Daniel determined in his heart that he would not pollute himself with the delicacies of the king and with his drinking wine. And he kept requesting of the principal court official that he might not pollute himself. (Daniel 1:8)
