~POPLARS, TORRENT VALLEY OF (28)

- That is why the leftovers and their stored goods that they have put up, they keep carrying them away right over the torrent valley of the poplars. (Isaiah 15:7)
- The prophet describes the escaping Moabites as fleeing with their goods across the torrent valley of the poplars. If their flight was to the South, as it seems likely to have been, this torrent valley would appear to refer to the torrent valley of Zered.
- From there they pulled away and took up camping by the torrent valley of Zered. (Numbers 21:12)
- At this time rise and make your way across the torrent valley of Zered. Accordingly we went crossing the torrent valley of Zered. (Deuteronomy 2:13)
- Which acted as the frontier boundary between Moab and Edom to the South. The torrent valley of Zered is generally identified with the Wadi el-Hasa', which flows into the South end of the Dead Sea. In its lower course it passes through a small plain that is somewhat swampy in places and could thus be a suitable place for poplars to have grown.
