

~PRESUMPTUOUSLY (100)

[English, In the Manner Of, arrogant, bigheaded, conceited, presuming, audacious, insolent, bold, rash, Opposite of, **modest**]

- Jethro was convinced that Yehowah God was greater than all other gods, because of what he had done for Israel freeing them from Egyptian bondage.
- Now I do know that Yehowah is greater than all the **other** gods by reason of this affair in which they acted **presumptuously** against them. (**Exodus 18:11**)
- Moses told Israel to listen to the orders of the Aaronic priesthood, for not to do so, would be acting **presumptuously** before Yehowah God.
- And all the people will hear and become afraid, and they will not act **presumptuously** anymore. (**Deuteronomy 17:13**)
- Pushing ahead **presumptuously** is the same as using uncanny power and terraphim, the same as using spiritism.
- For rebelliousness is the same as the sin of divination, and pushing ahead **presumptuously** the same as using uncanny power and teraphim. Since you have rejected the word of Yehowah, he accordingly rejects you from being king. (**1 Samuel 15:23**)
- Nehemiah showed that Pharaoh of Egypt had acted **presumptuously** against Israel, until Yehowah God made a name for himself by destroying them.
- Then you gave signs and miracles against Pharaoh and all his servants and all the people of his land, for you knew that they acted **presumptuously** against them, and you proceeded to make a name for yourself as at this day. (**Nehemiah 9:10**)
- Israel acted **presumptuously** against Yehowah God by not listening to his voice.
- And they themselves, even our forefathers, acted **presumptuously** and proceeded to harden their neck, and they

did not listen to your commandments. (**Nehemiah 9:16**)

- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your Law, they themselves even acted **presumptuously** and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own judicial decisions they sinned, which, if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. And they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their neck they hardened, and they did not listen. (**Nehemiah 9:29**)
- There must be a gathering together against Babylon, and a surrounding of her from all sides. There must be no escapees, for her way must linger no longer upon the earth. Give back to her according to her own activity.
- She has oppressed and suppressed people of the earth, and her way is one of fear of death and violence against innocent ones. Therefore do the same things to her. It is against Yehowah, that she has acted **presumptuously**, by rejecting his own understanding and substituting her own.
- Summon against Babylon archers, all who are treading the bow. Encamp against her all around. May there prove to be no escapees. Pay back to her according to her activity. According to all that she has done, do to her. For it is against Yehowah that she has acted **presumptuously**, against the Holy One of Israel. (**Jeremiah 50:29**)
- Daniel was also a man who had worked closely with the king Nebuchadnezzar, Belshazzar's father. Nebuchadnezzar had an experience where he became haughty and Yehowah changed his heart to that of a beast and took away his kingdom for seven years. Daniel reminded Belshazzar of this experience, which he no doubt knew about, but had forgotten. How like false religionists who know about Yehowah's dealings of the past, but who behave haughtily and **presumptuously** toward God and Christ, by extolling their own selves, and promoting their own kingdoms ahead of God.
- But when his heart became haughty and his own spirit became hard, so as to act **presumptuously**, he was brought down from the throne of his kingdom, and his own dignity was taken away from him. (**Daniel 5:20**)
