## ~PRESUMPTUOUS (155)

[English, arrogant, bigheaded, conceited, presuming, audacious, insolent, bold, rash, Opposite of, modest]

- The Psalmist asked Yehowah God to keep him from doing persumptuous acts, not letting them dominate him.
- Also from presumptuous acts hold your servant back, do not let them dominate me. In that case I shall be complete, and I shall have remained innocent from much transgression. (Psalms 19:13)
- The Psalmist showed that the presumptuous ones had risen up against him, the assembly of tyrannical ones was looking for his soul.
- O God, the presumptuous ones themselves have risen up against me, and the very assembly of tyrannical ones have looked for my soul, and they have not set you in front of themselves. (Psalms 86:14)
- The Psalmist thanked Yehowah God for rebuking the presumptuous ones who strayed from his commandments.
- You have rebuked the cursed presumptuous ones, who are straying from your commandments. (Psalms 119:21)
- The Psalmist showed that the presumptuous ones had derided him to the extreme, but he remained firm for Yehowah God's Law.
- The presumptuous ones themselves have derided me to the extreme. From your Law I have not deviated. (Psalms 119:51)
- The presumptuous ones smeared the Psalmist with falsehood, but he continued to observe Yehowah God's orders.
- The presumptuous have smeared me with falsehood. As for me, with all my heart I shall observe your orders. (Psalms 119:69)
- The Psalmist asked for the presumptuous one to be ashamed, for they misled him without cause.
- Let the presumptuous ones be ashamed, for without cause they

have misled me. As for me, I concern myself with your orders. (Psalms 119:78)

- The Psalmist showed, that the presumptuous ones had excavated pitfalls for him, men who did not act in accord with Yehowah God's Law.
- The presumptuous have excavated pitfalls to get me, those who are not in accord with your law. (Psalms 119:85)
- The Psalmist asked Yehowah God to go surety for him, and not to let the presumptuous ones defraud him.
- Act as a surety for your servant for what is good. May the presumptuous ones not defraud me. (Psalms 119:122)
- The name of one acting in a fury of presumptuousness is a self-assuming braggart.
- Presumptuous, self-assuming braggart is the name of the one who is acting in a fury of presumptuousness. (Proverbs 21:24)
- Wicked anointed sons in this time of the end chose to withhold divine light of insight coming from Yehowah in two fine books, Revealing The Sons Of God, and Insight On Daniel's Prophecies.
- Thus for their own badness and foolishness, or Kesil, Yehowah will let their own error come upon them. Since they withheld light or insight from others, even though they are supposed to be a light to the world, he now withholds light or insight from them, about his advancing purpose, thus keeping them in the darkness.
- They presumptuously claim to be his only voice on earth, but their own haughtiness will be exposed, when they themselves fail to see his advancing purpose unfolding. Thus he will bring low those haughty ones who claim to be his earthly organization but who defiantly stand in the way of doing his will, which is the gathering of the remaining sons of the Kingdom.
- And I shall certainly bring home its own badness upon the productive land, and their own error upon the wicked themselves. And I shall actually cause the pride of the presumptuous ones to cease, and the haughtiness of the tyrants I shall abase. (Isaiah 13:11)

- Immediately her leaders denounced what Jeremiah said, saying that Yehowah did not speak these words to Jeremiah and calling it a falsehood. They wanted to go down into Egypt and had already made up their minds before approaching Yehowah, as to what they would eventually do. They were therefore hypocrites, and they had no desire to do God's will.
- Azariah the son of Hoshaiah and Johanan the son of Kareah and all the presumptuous men proceeded to say to Jeremiah; It is a falsehood that you are speaking. Yehowah our God has not sent you, saying; Do not enter into Egypt to reside there as aliens. (Jeremiah 43:2)
- Yet at the present time, they are pronouncing presumptuous people happy, treating them as if they were righteous ones before their God. Also the doers of wickedness have been built up to perform further acts of wickedness, instead of having a holy priesthood call them into reproach for their error. They have tested out their God to see if they can cut corners in his service, and when they get away with anything, then this just emboldens them to cheat him even more.
- And at present we are pronouncing presumptuous people happy. Also, the doers of wickedness have been built up. Also, they have tested God out and keep getting away. (Malachi 3:15)
- Yehowah now warns his people of his coming day of vengeance against all the peoples of the earth, the Day of Yehowah. That day is coming burning like a fire, and all of the presumptuous people of the earth and all those practicing wickedness, will then become as mere dried stubble before the fire of his burning anger. That day will devour them all! It will leave to them neither root not bough, for the tree they have planted on the earth, will be completely destroyed, leaving nothing.
- For, look! The day is coming that is burning like the furnace, and all the presumptuous ones and all those doing wickedness must become as stubble. And the day that is coming will certainly devour them, Yehowah of armies has said, so that it will not leave to them either root or bough. (Malachi 4:1)
