~PRETENSE (29)

[English, charade, sham, façade, make-believe, deceipt, deception, simulation]

- The sailors who were sailing the boat made a pretense of lowering anchors, but were really going to escape and abandon the hip which might have killed all aboard.
- But when the sailors began seeking to escape from the boat and lowered the skiff into the sea under the pretense of intending to let down anchors from the prow. (Acts of Apostles 27:30)
- The rest of the Jewish Christians also joined Peter in his pretense of not eating with non-Jewish Christians and even Barnabus was led along in this pretense.
- The rest of the Jews also joined him in putting on this pretense, so that even Barnabas was led along with them in their pretense. (Galatians 2:13)
- Paul rejoiced that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, that the Christ is being publicised.
- What then? Nothing, except that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is being publicized, and in this I rejoice. In fact, I will also keep on rejoicing. (Philippians 1:18)
