

~PREVAILED (125)

[English, triumphed, succeeded, overcame, Opposite of, failed]

- The angel of Yehowah God when he saw that he had not **prevailed** over Jacob touched his socket of his thigh joint and made it get out of place, and thus the name change to Israel, from Jacob.
- When he got to see that he had not **prevailed** over him, then he touched the socket of his thigh joint, and the socket of Jacob's thigh joint got out of place during his grappling with him. (Genesis 32:25)
- Then he said; Your name will no longer be called Jacob but Israel, for you have contended with God and with men so that you at last **prevailed**. (Genesis 32:28)
- Finally the words of King David **prevailed** over Joab and his chiefs, and they followed the counsel of David to number the people.
- Finally the kings word **prevailed** upon Joab and the chiefs of the military forces. So Joab and the chiefs of the military forces went out from before the king to register the people Israel. (2 Samuel 24:4)
- The kings word, however, **prevailed** over Joab, so that Joab went out and walked through all Israel, after which he came to Jerusalem. (1 Chronicles 21:4)
- Solomon **prevailed** over the cities of Hamath-zobah and went building there.
- Furthermore, Solomon went to Hamath-zobah and **prevailed** over it. (2 Chronicles 8:3)
- The Psalmist showed that his enemies had shown hostility toward him from his youth, but they had never **prevailed** over him.
- Long enough they have shown hostility to me from my youth. Yet they have not **prevailed** over me. (Psalms 129:2)
- Yehowah God fooled Jeremiah and used his strength against him, so that Yehowah God **prevailed**, and thus Jeremiah was made a

laughingstock among Yehowah God's people and everyone held him in derision.

- **You have fooled me, O Yehowah, so that I was fooled. You used your strength against me, so that you **prevailed**. I became an object of laughter all day long, everyone is holding me in derision. (Jeremiah 20:7)**
- **Jeremiah now saw a situation where the king's wives were being brought out to the Babylonian princes, and they are saying to the women, the men at peace with you have allured you, they have retreated in the opposite direction.**
- **And, look! All the women that have been left remaining in the house of the king of Judah are being brought out to the princes of the king of Babylon, and they are saying; The men at peace with you have allured you and **prevailed** over you. They have caused your foot to sink down into the very ooze, they have retreated in the opposite direction. (Jeremiah 38:22)**
- **Also Yehowah God refers to the contending with one of his angels that Jacob later did to obtain a blessing, so that he gradually **prevailed**. At Bethel he wept before his God to find his favor, and there he got to find Yehowah God, and it was in Bethel that Yehowah God began speaking to Jacob, as he had spoken to Abraham and Isaac before him.**
- **And he kept contending with an angel and gradually **prevailed**. He wept, that he might implore favor for himself. At Bethel He got to find him, and there He began talking with us. (Hosea 12:4)**
- **Then Yehowah God shows, that the Jews have tried to push Yehowah God out to the very boundary of their existence. The very men in covenant with him have tried to deceive him. The men at peace with the Jews have **prevailed** against them. Those eating of their spiritual portions, from the Bible, will place a net under the Jews, as ones in whom there is no discernment.**
- **They are unspiritual men, and their rejection of Christ and Christianity is proof of that. They do not even understand their own holy writings. They have pushed Yehowah to the very boundary of their existence, and they are not a people centered around him and his true way, for they have rejected his son, Jesus Christ.**

- **As far as the boundary they have sent you. The very men in covenant with you have all deceived you. The men at peace with you have **prevailed** against you. Those eating food with you will place a net under you as one in whom there is no discernment. (Obadiah 1:7)**
- **With that the man with the wicked spirit within him, leaped upon them, and then got the mastery of one after the other, and **prevailed** so well against them, that they all fled wounded and naked out of that house. Since Yehowah God did not support them, they could not overpower the demons, and they got a demonstration of the power of these wicked creatures.**
- **With that the man in whom the wicked spirit was leaped upon them, got the mastery of one after the other, and **prevailed** against them, so that they fled naked and wounded out of that house. (Acts of Apostles 19:16)**
