

~PREVAIL (190)

[English, triumph, win through, succeed, overcome, Opposite of, fail]

- Joshua and Caleb tried to still the fears of the people saying that Israel could certainly **prevail** over the people of Canaan.
- Then Caleb tried to still the people toward Moses and went on to say; Let us go up directly, and we are bound to take possession of it, because we can surely **prevail** over it. (**Numbers 13:30**)
- The hand of Midian came to **prevail** over the Israelites.
- And the hand of Midian came to **prevail** over Israel. Due to Midian the sons of Israel made for themselves the underground store places that were in the mountains, and the caves and the places difficult to approach. (**Judges 6:2**)
- The axis Lord of the Philistines asked Delilah to find out for them, just how they could **prevail** over Sampson and where the power of his strength lay.
- And the axis lords of the Philistines proceeded to come up to her and to say to her; Fool him and see in what his great power is and with what we can **prevail** over him and with what we are certain to tie him so as to master him, and we, for our part, shall give you each one thousand one hundred silver pieces. (**Judges 16:5**)
- Haman's family warned him, that because Mordecai was a Jew he would certainly not **prevail** over him.
- And Haman went on to relate to Zeresh his wife and to all his friends everything that had befallen him. At that his wise men and Zeresh his wife said to him; If it is from the seed of the Jews that Mordecai is before whom you have started to fall, you will not **prevail** against him, but you will without fail fall before him. (**Esther 6:13**)
- The Psalmist relates about wicked ones who say with the tongue that they will **prevail** over righteous ones, and no one will be master over them.

- Those who have said; With our tongue we shall **prevail**. Our lips are with us. Who will be a master to us? (**Psalms 12:4**)
- Yehowah is certainly the grand keeper of his promises to mankind. As he told Jeremiah they will not **prevail** over you, for I am with you.
- And they will be certain to fight against you, but they will not **prevail** against you, for I am with you, is the utterance of Yehowah, to deliver you. (**Jeremiah 1:19**)
- The continued bad actions of Jehovah's Witnesses cause Yehowah to remain resentful toward them. They have refused to see their error and have not turned around. Will he simply keep watching this bad situation forever allowing them to **prevail**?
- Should one stay resentful to time indefinite, or keep watching something forever? Look! You have spoken, and you went on to do bad things and **prevail**. (**Jeremiah 3:5**)
- Yehowah God shows his own power to act for the waves of the sea become boisterous, but still they cannot **prevail**, and the oceans stay in their place. Surely men must also realize their place within Yehowah God's arrangements.
- Do you not fear even me, is the utterance of Yehowah, or are you in no severe pains even because of me, who have set the sand as the boundary for the sea, an indefinitely lasting regulation that it cannot pass over? Although its waves toss themselves, still they cannot **prevail**, and although they do become boisterous, still they cannot pass over it. (**Jeremiah 5:22**)
- Yehowah has prepared, his Son of Man, to take a firm and an unmovable stand against those ones who fight against him and work against his purposes. He has guided him in preparing fifty-four books of spiritual understanding from his word, that explain in detail, both how and why, it is about to be fulfilled.
- They will be sure to fight against this, but they will not be able to scripturally refute any of it. Yehowah is with the Son of Man and his **word** is in his mouth.
- And I have made you to this people a fortified copper wall, and they will certainly fight against you, but they will not **prevail** over

you. For I am with you, to save you and to deliver you, is the utterance of Yehowah. ([Jeremiah 15:20](#))

- Jeremiah there in Jerusalem under seige heard the frightful reports and many ther bid him peace, but they were wanting for him to fall so that they could **prevail** against him and not have to hear his prophesying any longer.

- For I heard the bad report of many. There was fright all around. Tell out, that we may tell out about him. Every mortal man bidding me, Peace! They are watching for my limping. Perhaps he will be fooled, so that we may **prevail** against him and take our revenge upon him. ([Jeremiah 20:10](#))

- Jeremiah knew Yehowah God was with him, like a terrible mighty one, and that those fighting against him would not **prevail**, but rather stumble.

- But Yehowah was with me like a terrible mighty one. That is why the very ones persecuting me will stumble and not **prevail**. They will certainly be put to much shame, because they will not have prospered. Their indefinitely lasting humiliation will be one that will not be forgotten. ([Jeremiah 20:11](#))

- Though promising Jeremiah to help him, Zedekiah now acted along with his princes and gave Jeremiah into their hands. He felt powerless to restrain them, for they were all against him.

- So King Zedekiah said; Look! He is in your hands. For there is nothing at all in which the king himself can **prevail** against you. ([Jeremiah 38:5](#))

- Then one of his princes of this king of the south will become strong, even stronger than his predecessor, and he will extend the dominion of his rule over a wider range and **prevail**.

- And the king of the south will become strong, even one of his princes, and he will **prevail** against him and will certainly rule with extensive dominion greater than that ones ruling power. ([Daniel 11:5](#))

- And one from the sprout of her roots will certainly stand up in his position, and he will come to the military force and come against the fortress of the king of the north and will certainly act against

them and **prevail**. (**Daniel 11:7**)

- The **Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses**, are the **disgusting thing**, that causes desolation in our modern world, and through smooth talk and apostasy, they are leading God's people away from the doing of his glorious will, of gathering his anointed sons. Yet despite their efforts to mislead, there are true sons of God in our world, and they **know their God** and so, they will **prevail** and act effectively.
- And those who are acting wickedly against the covenant, he will lead into apostasy by means of smooth words. But as regards the people who are knowing their God, they will **prevail** and act effectively. (**Daniel 11:32**)
- The outcome of this war has never really been in any doubt because two thousand years ago Yehowah told us the outcome prophetically. Satan has been able to deceive people in heaven and on earth as to the identity of the true seed, but now that the abyss has been opened and the 144,000 have been born his deception is over in heaven.
- So he is now cast down to the earth so that his deception of mankind can likewise be exposed to them. The heavens are thus cleansed. The sun, moon, stars can now shine there. However it means woe for the earth and the sea.
- But it did not **prevail**, neither was a place found for them any longer in heaven. (**Revelation 12:8**)
