

~PROLONG (28)

[English, extend, delay, put off, make longer, lengthen, draw out, protract, Opposite of, **curtail**]

- The congregator stated that he that is hating unjust profit will **prolong** his days.
- A leader that is in want of true discernment is also abundant in fraudulent practices, but he that is hating unjust profit will **prolong** his days. (**Proverbs 28:16**)
- The wicked one will not prolong his days, which are like a shadow, a temporary lease on life, because he does not fear God.
- But it will not turn out well at all with the wicked one, neither will he **prolong** his days that are like a shadow, because he is not in fear of God. (**Ecclesiastes 8:13**)
- Yehowah speaks of crushing and making sick his Messiah. However, he would act as a guilt offering for others and he would **prolong** his own days for his submission to the doing of God's will.
- But Yehowah himself took delight in crushing him, he made him sick. If you will set his soul as a guilt offering, he will see his offspring, he will **prolong** his days, and in his hand what is the delight of Yehowah will succeed. (**Isaiah 53:10**)
