## ~PRONOUNCEMENTS (73)

[English, statements, assertions, declarations, announcements, decrees, verdicts, proclamations]

- Jeremiah showed that Jerusalem many prophets had visioned for her worthless and misleading pronouncements.
- Your own prophets have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things; And they have not uncovered your error in order to turn back your captivity; But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (Lamentations 2:14)
- This is the Moses who came to be with the congregation in the wilderness, and who received living sacred pronouncements from Yehowah God through his angel.
- This is he that came to be among the congregation in the wilderness with the angel that spoke to him on Mount Sinai and with our forefathers, and he received living sacred pronouncements to give you. (Acts of Apostles 7:38)
- Paul felt as a Jew, that there were many benefits. The first point he makes, is that they were entrusted with these sacred Laws and principles, Yehowah God's pronouncements, and so they as a people would have to keep them, and they would review them from time to time, for that was a part of this Law Covenant.
- A great deal in every way. First of all, because they were entrusted with the sacred pronouncements of God. (Romans 3:2)
- Paul's letter is addressed to Hebrew Christians, and as such they should have a better appreciation of these things, for they came out of a system of things, that taught these basic principles to all under it, for many years, before coming to be anointed Christians.
- Thus Paul shows, that they should be teachers of others by this time, but they are not, for they have not made the spiritual progress, as they should have. Instead they are ones needing to have the elementary things of the sacred pronouncements of God explained to them.
- For, indeed, although you ought to be teachers in view of the

time, you again need someone to teach you from the beginning the elementary things of the sacred pronouncements of God, and you have become such as need milk, not solid food. (Hebrews 5:12)

- When we speak to our brothers we should speak as it were, the sacred pronouncements of God. If we minister to others, then we should do so according to the strength that God supplies through his Holy Spirit. Thus in all things, God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, the head of the Christian congregation. The glory and might belong to Yehowah God forever and ever.
- If anyone speaks, let him speak as it were the sacred pronouncements of God, if anyone ministers, let him minister as dependent on the strength that God supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. The glory and the might are his forever and ever. Amen. (1 Peter 4:11)
