[English, states, asserts, declares, announces, decrees, judges, proclams]

- The priest who pronounces the man clean must then present the man before Yehowah at the tent of meeting.
- And the priest who pronounces him clean must present the man who is cleansing himself, and the things, before Yehowah at the entrance of the tent of meeting. (Leviticus 14:11)
- Eliphaz the Temanite proceeded to say that Job's own words pronounced him wicked.
- Your mouth pronounces you wicked, and not I, and your own lips answer against you. (Job 15:6)
- Yehowah pronounces the wicked ideas of the wicked one as wicked.
- One that is good gets approval from Yehowah, but the man of wicked ideas he pronounces wicked. (Proverbs 12:2)
