~PRONOUNCING (72)

[English, stating, asserting, declaring, announcing, decreeing, judging, proclaming]

- Solomon asked Yehowah God in prayer to hear his servants from the heavens and pronounce the wicked one wicked and the righteous one righteous.
- Then may you yourself hear from the heavens, and you must act and judge your servants by pronouncing the wicked one wicked by putting his way upon his own head, and by pronouncing the righteous one righteous by giving to him according to his own righteousness. (1 Kings 8:32)
- Then may you yourself hear from the heavens, and you must act and judge your servants so as to pay back the wicked by putting his course upon his own head and by pronouncing the righteous one righteous by giving to him according to his own righteousness. (2 Chronicles 6:23)
- Anyone pronouncing the wicked one righteous or the righteous one wicked, is something detestable to Yehowah God.
- Anyone pronouncing the wicked one righteous and anyone pronouncing the righteous one wicked, even both of them are something detestable to Yehowah. (Proverbs 17:15)
- Isaiah spoke of men pronouncing the wicked one righteous and the righteous one wicked for a bribe, thus taking away his righteousness.
- Those who are pronouncing the wicked one righteous in consideration of a bribe, and who take away even the righteousness of the righteous one from him! (Isaiah 5:23)
- Then Yehowah God shows what is wrong with his people, their wicked practices. They are pronouncing curses against one another and practicing deception. They commit murder, steal, and commit adultery against their own mates. They have not put a stop to acts of violence, and so these have cascaded out of control into still other acts of violence. They are not like him. They are not his people.

- There are the pronouncing of curses and practicing of deception and murdering and stealing and committing of adultery that have broken forth, and acts of bloodshed have touched other acts of bloodshed. (Hosea 4:2)
- Yet at the present time, they are pronouncing presumptuous people happy, treating them as if they were righteous ones before their God. Also the doers of wickedness have been built up to perform further acts of wickedness, instead of having a holy priesthood call them into reproach for their error. They have tested out their God to see if they can cut corners in his service, and when they get away with anything, then this just emboldens them to cheat him even more.
- And at present we are pronouncing presumptuous people happy. Also, the doers of wickedness have been built up. Also, they have tested God out and keep getting away. (Malachi 3:15)
