## ~PROSPERITY (80)

[English, wealth, affluence, oppulence, riches, success, richness, Opposite of, poverty]

- Moses told Israel not to work for the prosperity of Midian over what they did through Balaam.
- You must not work for their peace and their prosperity all your days to time indefinite. (Deuteronomy 23:6)
- Yehowah God promised to make Israel overflow with prosperity.
- Yehowah will also make you overflow indeed with prosperity in the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your ground, on the ground that Yehowah swore to your forefathers to give you. (Deuteronomy 28:11)
- And Yehowah your God will indeed make you have more than enough in every work of your hand, in the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your soil, resulting in prosperity, because Yehowah will again exult over you for good, just as he exulted over your forefathers. (Deuteronomy 30:9)
- And I did not put faith in the words until I had come that my own eyes might see, and, look! I had not been told the half. You have surpassed in wisdom and prosperity the things heard to which I listened. (1 Kings 10:7)
- Israelites were told through Ezra, not to work for the prosperity of Canaanites, nor to take them in marriage.
- And now your daughters do not you people give to their sons, neither their daughters do you accept for your sons, and to time indefinite you must not work for their peace and their prosperity, in order, that you may grow strong and certainly eat the good of the land and indeed take possession of it for your sons to time indefinite. (Ezra 9:12)
- The Psalmist prophesied that Yehowah God was bringing forth prisoners into full prosperity. Yet those remaining stubborn would reside in a scorched land.

- God is causing the solitary ones to dwell in a house, he is bringing forth prisoners into full prosperity. However, as for the stubborn, they have to reside in a scorched land. (Psalms 68:6)
- Nebuchadnezzar was counseled by Daniel to act righteously, and show mercy to the poor ones. If he did this, there might occur a lengthening of his prosperity. I have been, by writing this scroll trying to help the poor ones who have lacked spiritual food for years, but as yet I have no way to publish it widely.
- Therefore, O king, may my counsel seem good to you, and remove your own sins by righteousness, and your iniquity by showing mercy to the poor ones. Maybe there will occur a lengthening of your prosperity. (Daniel 4:27)
- So Demetrius gathered together the other silversmiths and all those whose living was impacted by the production of such idols, thus affecting their prosperity and inciting them to riot, telling them that their very means of living was being threatened by the apostle Paul and his message, that the ones made by men, are not gods, only worthless idols.
- And he gathered them and those who worked at such things and said; Men, you well know that from this business we have our prosperity. (Acts of Apostles 19:25)
