- The writing against the Jews was published in all the jurisdictional districts of the realm.
- A copy of the writing to be given as Law in all the different jurisdictional districts was being published to all the peoples, for them to become ready for this day. (Esther 3:14)
- A copy of the writing was to be given as Law throughout all the different jurisdictional districts, published to all the peoples, that the Jews should become ready for this day to avenge themselves upon their enemies. (Esther 8:13)
- So Paul now shows, that he was there to publish to them, that through this one, they could gain a true forgiveness of their sins, something that they could never obtain under the terms of the Law Covenant.
- Let it therefore be known to you, brothers, that through this One a forgiveness of sins is being published to you. (Acts of Apostles 13:38)
- So after Paul and Barnabas had spent many days in Antioch, Paul said to Barnabas, that it would be fine to return to visit the brothers in all of the cities where they had published the word of Yehowah God on their first trip.
- Now after some days Paul said to Barnabas; Above all things, let us return and visit the brothers in every one of the cities in which we published the word of Yehowah to see how they are. (Acts of Apostles 15:36)
- Yet when the Jews in nearby Thessalonica learned that the word of God was also being published by Paul in Beroea, they came there also to incite the people of that city against Paul and Silas.
- But when the Jews from Thessalonica learned that the word of God was published also in Beroea by Paul, they came there also to incite and agitate the masses. (Acts of Apostles 17:13)
