- The Levites purified themselves and then Aaron caused them to move to and fro as a wave offering to Yehowah God.
- So the Levites purified themselves and washed their garments, after which Aaron caused them to move to and fro as a wave offering before Yehowah. Then Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them. (Numbers 8:21)
- Items were purified by passing them through the fire or then washing them in water.
- Everything that is processed with fire, you should pass through the fire, and it must be clean. Only it should be purified by the water for cleansing. And everything that is not processed with fire you should pass through the water. (Numbers 31:23)
- Nehemiah purified the priesthood from everything foreign and then assigned duties to the priests and Levites.
- And I purified them from everything foreign and proceeded to assign duties to the priests and to the Levites, each one in his own work. (Nehemiah 13:30)
- The male goat and the bull typified two aspects of sin, rebelliousness and improper use of power respectively. This second purification of the altar was done in the same manner as the first.
- And on the second day you will bring near a buck of the goats, a sound one, as a sin offering, and they must purify the altar from sin the same as they purified it from sin with the young bull. (Ezekiel 43:22)
- Then Peter related, that God made no distinction at all then, between Jews and Gentiles, but that he also purified their hearts by faith.
- And he made no distinction at all between us and them, but purified their hearts by faith. (Acts of Apostles 15:9)

- Peter now encourages them, that now that they have purified their souls by applying the truth in their lives through their heartfelt obedience to God's Holy Spirit, which has resulted in a true and unhypocritical brotherly affection for one another, that they should now love one another intensely from the heart, for they are going to spend eternity together in their joint service to God in heaven.
- Now that you have purified your souls by your obedience to the truth with unhypocritical brotherly affection as the result, love one another intensely from the heart. (1 Peter 1:22)
